2.1 Motion to Adopt New Constitution

For Decision

Motion: That the members of Te Tira Ahu Pae agree to adopt the proposed new Constitution, titled Constitution of MUSA, which has been prepared in accordance with the Incorporated Societies Act 2022 and the Charities Act 2005.

The full legal name of the association is Massey University Students' Association Palmerston North Incorporated. Within this Constitution, the Association may also be referred to as MUSA or Manawatū Association.

If approved, this new Constitution will be submitted to the Registrar for approval, to replace the current Constitution in full.

2.2 Reregistering as an Incorporated Society

For Decision

MUSA is currently registered as an incorporated society and is required to comply with the Incorporated Societies Act. A new version of the Act came into effect in 2022, and all incorporated societies must complete the reregistration process by 5 April 2026.

MUSA intends to reregister well before the deadline to allow time to address any questions that may arise about our Constitution.

Reregistration must be approved by the Association, as it means we will be operating under the updated rules set out in the 2022 Act. If we do not reregister by the required date, MUSA will no longer be recognised as an incorporated society.

This decision is important to ensure the Association remains compliant and continues to operate effectively into the future.

Motion: That MUSA reregisters as an incorporated society under the Incorporated Societies Act 2022.
